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Siltronic AG donates €7,000 to Nepal project

Munich, December 18, 2020 – With a company-wide fundraising campaign, Siltronic AG contributed a total of 7,000 euros to this year's virtual Nepal Run organized by the Freiberg high school student company Namaste Nepal.

Over a period of four weeks, employees at all production sites and sales offices were able to support the campaign with their sports achievements. Kilometers were collected in the disciplines of running, cycling, hiking, Nordic walking and swimming. A total of 155 employees from Asia, Europe and the USA participated.
